### Bethesda Club Meaning

The name for the Bethesda Club is derived from the Biblical passage in John 5:1-8. In this story, Jesus encounters a sick and disabled person lying by the Pool of Bethesda. To be healed this person needs the assistance of others to enter the pool when the waters are stirred. By giving to Swiss Village you help our residents get the quality care they need to be healed.

Bethesda comes from two Hebrew words “*Beit*” and “*Hesed*” which means “House of Mercy”. Benevolent giving through estate planning helps Swiss Village to create a “House of Mercy” where residents receive assistance for their care and healing.
