Greetings! It is with great joy that I report to you that we have **no new active cases of COVID-19** amongst our resident family nor our employee family! We rejoice in the fact that this low level of positivity on our campus, coupled with the extremely low positivity within our County, has allowed us to remove many of the restrictions that had been in place for so very long! And that reduction can continue and remain so long as there is no new outbreak amongst the employees or the residents. Just please be mindful that we are still obliged to immediately return to restrictions if we detect a positive case (residents) or a positive case that leads to additional positive cases within (employees). I will remind you one last time, it is for this reason that it is so very important for you all to take every step available to you to mitigate any potential of spread of this bug which is still alive and thriving in our communities. Please, continue to practice the 3-Ws... **w**ear a mask at all times when inside the building (unless alone in an office or in your own apartment without others – if another enters, please mask up!), **w**ash hands often (and disinfect surface areas) and **w**atch your distance (6 ft of separation) – even when here visiting! The final, and most critical, step to this prevention, please take advantage of the vaccine now that it is available to the total adult population. You may make an appointment at several different locations... just please get the shot! And, employees, we will reward you with a nice bonus if you finish your vaccinations by July 1, please don't forget!

Our historical numbers remain the same as we have been reporting to you over the last weeks, I will not belabor that here.

**Visitation:** Please familiarize yourself with the rules that allow/enable you to be able to visit a loved one here on campus. Please remember, you must wear your mask at all times, maintain proper social distancing at all times, if the resident has been vaccinated you are free to give them a brief hug while masked – asking that you (and resident) wash hands before and after the interaction, and you still may not eat together during the visit. Please feel free to bring food for your loved one to enjoy after your visit, but no food shared during the visit – unless you are outside for a socially-distanced visit out there. To that end, as the weather improves, we will be providing a few tables with umbrellas at which you could take advantage of such a visit. Please be on the lookout for that placement!
