First, thank you, everyone, for your patience, your support, your cooperation and for working with us through a very difficult time.

Over the past 16 months, the pandemic has presented many challenges along with the need for many restrictions and guidelines. I'm happy to share we're updating our current COVID-19 procedures to reflect the updated regulations outlined by the CDC and the Indiana Department of Health.

These changes include updated guidelines for **visitation, mask requirements** and **employee COVID-19 testing protocols**.

COVID-19 Dashboard for Current Restrictions 6/21/2021

Have you been vaccinated? Our guidelines have changed. There is new information below for everyone. However, if you have been vaccinated, you will find some new and updated guidelines regarding visitation.

Visitation	
<p>Healthcare</p>	<p><u>Visitation Schedule Check in Hours:</u></p> <p><u>Healthcare Entrance</u> Monday – Friday: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.</p> <p><u>Front Entrance</u> Sunday – Saturday 7:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.</p> <p>Visitors must check in during designated hours above. Visits are not limited in length and signups are not required.</p> <p>All visitors must check in and screen at the kiosk.</p> <p><u>Residents in Private Rooms:</u> If resident and all visitors are vaccinated, they may have more than two visitors at a time. If residents and visitors are both vaccinated, no social distancing or masks are required during the visit. Unvaccinated residents in private rooms may have two visitors at a time in their healthcare room.</p> <p><u>Semi-Private Rooms:</u> Residents who live in a shared healthcare room may have two visitors at one time. If residents and visitors are both vaccinated, no social distancing or masks are required during the visit.</p> <p>Residents may visit with guests outside, weather permitting.</p> <p>The private dining room may be reserved to accommodate multiple visitors, if desired, by signing up online at www.swissvillage.org/healthcare-resident-visitation/</p>

	<p>All visitors must check in at the Swiss Village Front Desk at the kiosk. Visits are not limited in length.</p> <p>Residents are not limited to the number of visitors at one time.</p> <p>If resident and visitors are both vaccinated, no social distancing or masks are required during the visit.</p> <p>Visitors are not permitted to stay overnight in licensed areas.</p> <p>Visitors are permitted to stay overnight in Independent Living.</p> <p>Residents may visit outdoors, weather permitting.</p>

COVID-19 Testing	
Employees Volunteers EFC (Essential Family Caregiver)	<p>Staff members, volunteers, and essential family caregivers who are vaccinated no longer need to be routinely tested for COVID-19. However, if we are in outbreak testing mode or if the county positivity rate is greater than 10%, testing is required regardless of vaccination status.</p>

Excursions	
Healthcare Assisted Living Residential Living Independent Living	<p>Residents are permitted to leave the facility for trips, excursions, and medical appointments.</p> <p>Per state guidance, unvaccinated residents are required to quarantine if gone for more than 24 hours.</p> <p>Residents may go on walks outside with visitors.</p>

Dining & Café	
Healthcare Assisted Living Residential Living Independent Living	<p>Fully vaccinated residents and visitors may dine together in a private room, semi-private room with the curtain pulled, or in a private dining area.</p> <p>Visitors are not permitted to eat in the dining room or café.</p> <p>Visitors may purchase items in the café to go.</p>

	Visitors and residents may eat outside while maintaining proper distance.

Safety	
Healthcare Assisted Living Residential Living	<p><u>Face Masks:</u></p> <p>Face masks are not required for visitors under the age of two.</p> <p>If resident and visitors are both vaccinated, no mask is required during visitation. However, masks are required to/from the visitation area (ie: resident room, apartment, designated meeting area).</p>
Independent Living	<p>Masks are not required in the designated independent living areas (ie: Zurich, Lucerne, Basel, Zermatt). However, once an independent living resident or visitor enters the main part of the building, masks are required due to licensure status.</p>
Volunteers	<p>Volunteers must always wear face masks while volunteering.</p>
Healthcare Assisted Living Residential Living Independent Living Volunteers Employees	<p><u>Hand Hygiene:</u> Visitors and Residents must use soap and water or hand sanitizer before and after physical touch during visits.</p> <p><u>Screening:</u> Visitors will be screened for COVID-19 signs and symptoms including temperature. Visitors who are not feeling well are not permitted to visit.</p> <p><u>Social Distancing:</u> Watch your distances. When at all possible please remain 6 feet apart.</p>
