## Visitation Guidelines and Constraints

### Healthcare

- We're unable to have indoor and outdoor visits for residents in Sonnenblum, Alpenrose, Lavendel, and Edelweiss Place.
- Essential Family Caregivers (EFC's) may continue to enter the building and be with their loved ones.
- Transportation remains available for medical appointments only. Per the Indiana Department of Health, transportation for all other activities will not be available.
- Beauty shop services are not available at this time.

### Assisted Living

- There are currently no restrictions.
- Visitors must check-in at the front desk prior to visit.

### Residential Living

- There are currently no restrictions.
- Visitors must check-in at the front desk prior to visit.

### Independent Living

- There are currently no restrictions
- Visitors must check-in at the front desk prior to visit.
- Westenfeld continues to serve as our designated COVID-19 care area. Residents living in Zurich and Lucerne will not be able to walk through this hallway.
