RE: Update of campus status – Holcomb’s Back on Track Plan

DATE: May 6, 2020

Greetings all! By now most, if not all, of you have heard about Governor Holcomb’s “Back on Track” plan that was discussed this past Friday during his daily briefing. We listened in, too, and based upon his plan are sharing an update of where things stand for Swiss Village and her residents. Bottom line, based upon the fact that Holcomb’s plan continues protections for seniors, aged 65+, asking them to “remain at home” until stage 3 of the plan which commences on May 24, we are following his counsel and asking you to continue with the protective measures we have had in place for several weeks now until *at least* that date. **For our North Campus folks**, this means, please continue to remain on your campus, allow us to do your groceries and your pharmacy pickups until *at least* that time. No visitors inside your apartments, please do not visit inside of other residents’ units, go outside... visit outside... please maintain the current social distancing requirements. Please refrain from any travel that would have you going through a drive-through nor exiting your vehicle at any time until after the 24<sup>th</sup>... pending the Governor does not change this timing. You will also be restricted from visiting the South Campus until such time as those restrictions are changed. **For our South Campus folks**, unfortunately we are going to need to be a bit more restraining as of yet, due to the fact that our building is connected to the Healthcare Center. There will continue to be no visitation from outside to the Healthcare Center until Step 5 of the plan, which means July 4! However, we are beginning to arrange for short visits of on-campus spouses and parents with each other at appointed times and for brief visits. We understand the importance of this contact. On the south campus, including our IL apartment folks, please bear with us as we watch for further details about the loosening of restrictions, but for now and possibly up until July 4, please plan on maintaining status quo until otherwise being informed.

We are reviewing the potential for opening (maybe softly) the Wellness Pavilion, the Kinderhaus Daycare Center and the beauty/barber shops on a restricted basis, but **not before May 24**. I know the hair is an issue... bear with us just a couple of more weeks... more information will come out about these areas as openings of some sort may commence around or after that date. Thank you ALL for your patience and understanding as we continue to try to present you with a virus-free environment!
