Good morning! I am pleased to inform you that we continue to trend with no new resident positive test results. We will be testing nursing residents again this week. We do have two new positive test results from employee testing this past Thursday. We just received the results this morning. Both employees were/are totally asymptomatic and are now quarantined at home for the ten-day period. We will continue to monitor any potential exposures that may have resulted from these two employees and their work times. Our biggest aim is the protection of all residents and employees from any active spread of the COVID-19 virus, and we continue our vigilant efforts accordingly. It is imperative that we all continue to practice our safe and clean hygienic practices of wearing masks at all times when around others, practice safe distancing, refrain from visiting in crowds, wash hands often and for 20 seconds at a time, and disinfect high touch surface areas frequently.

Tomorrow we are scheduled to provide our first round of the Moderna vaccinations (with CVS Pharmacy) to 195 residents and employees. While this number is terrific, it could/should be even much higher! I am hopeful that those of you who have chosen to not be inoculated with this first round here will think it through and join in on round #2 four weeks from now. More information to follow on rounds two and three. I am also aware that many of you have already gone to AMH for their Pfizer clinics, and I am very thankful for that! The more folks that we have who agree to become vaccinated, the sooner we can likely get to the other side of this Pandemic and its ugly consequences. Please pray about it and consider helping to protect yourselves, our residents and your co-workers.

Our historic numbers since early last March include now 113 employees, 7 contract employees and 68 residents having tested positive at some point. 109 employees, all 7 contract employees and 62 residents have recovered. We are thankful for the way in which our overall impact has not been significant, and we pray that we continue with that kind of experience. We still must report that we lost 6 of our beloved residents during their positive moments with the virus.

Thank you again for your loving and loyal support and prayers! We cannot do this without it! And, we are going to make it through this, **together!**
