RE: Positive COVID Test results
DATE: October 23, 2020

I truly wish I had better news. But unfortunately, I need to report the fact that our latest testing results have yielded five positive tests out of 158 tests that have been checked by our laboratory from our employee testing this week. Further we were made aware, yesterday, of an additional employee positive test that was procured earlier in the week. And finally, just this morning, we were apprised of a positive resident in our Independent Living section. We still have about another 110 tests awaiting processing from our employee testing. Fortunately, most all of our positive cases have had few/minor to no symptoms, but a couple of our folks have had some regular symptoms. Our resident is currently being monitored at the hospital, and the spouse is quarantined in the apartment.

For the time being, we will not be adjusting any visitation in the Healthcare side of our operation and we will be conducting regular monitoring of any residents that may have had a direct exposure to any of the cases. Nearly all of our current cases have little to no direct contact in the Healthcare wings. However, due to the potential exposures in the Residential, Assisted Living and the Independent Living areas, we are going to temporarily restrict indoor visitations for a two-week period. Further we are asking that all residents of Independent Living self-monitor for any signs/symptoms of the virus and if observed, immediately notify your physician AND our Blumengarten nursing staff for further counsel on next steps. For the time being we are asking ALL South Campus residents to refrain from leaving the South Campus for any reason except medically necessary trips, for two weeks. You are free to walk the hallways and walk outdoors to get your exercise, come to the dining area and café, but while indoors, please continue to attend to the hygienic instructions that we have given so often! Wear your mask, always maintain social distance, disinfect often, wash your hands often. Please report any and all atypical symptoms you might encounter. But again, for two weeks, please refrain from leaving the South Campus. North Campus is free to come and go as you wish using due care... but for these two weeks we will ask you to not enter the South Campus buildings.

Everyone, we need to be serious about this. Now more than ever! As the cases are creeping up in our County, they have now made it into our corridors. Let's be most vigilant and attentive! And let's wipe this thing out, now! Please pray for our positive cases, that their endurance be strengthened and that their physical stamina be strong! That they have minimal impact from their exposure, and that we are able to contain and minimize the spread. We will make it through this, and we will do so **together!** Meanwhile we will continue to enhance our sanitization efforts and monitor all residents accordingly.
