RE: Additional Positive Results

Greetings! I am sorry to inform you that we have had four additional employee tests now returned with positive results. All of these employees are employed within the Nursing Department, and due to that fact, we will now be closing our visitation for at least a two-week period. Interestingly all four of these employees have reported no signs nor symptoms of the COVID virus, as has been the case with nearly ALL of our reported positive tests. However, in light of our need to take every possible precaution, we are going to take the necessary steps to ensure there will be no further spread of this virus!

As reported yesterday, we reported new findings of six employees and one Independent Living resident with positive test results. This now takes us up to a total of ten current employees and one resident that we know of currently dealing with new positive results. All of these employees are now in the process of completing the required quarantine period. The resident is hospitalized as a further precaution.

Please know we are taking every step possible to mitigate this situation and are taking the extra steps to further our disinfecting and monitoring of the residents. Beyond that, every nursing resident will be tested every three to seven days, as well as all employees. This testing will continue for at least a two-week period and until there are no tests that return positive. Additional steps will be taken of the course of the coming days.

I cannot stress enough the importance of taking your own precautions. Please practice social distancing at all times! Frequent hand-washing and the wearing of a mask at all times is critical. The safety and wellbeing of our residents and employees is of utmost importance and we will take every precaution available to us to further solidify that fact.
