RE: COVID Results Update

Greetings all! As the November chill finally settles in, so does the realization that the virus has settled in for a while at Swiss Village. You already have the results of Monday's nursing resident testing. Tuesday, we tested all AL/RL residents for their third week... all of those tests fortunately have returned negative once again! We have, so far, mitigated the spread of the bug from entering the resident areas of those sections of living! Fortunately, our three+ week quarantine for this side of the campus has been working the way intended. We will be discussing any potential loosening of the restrictions for the AL/RL/IL part of the South Campus over the coming days as we receive additional results from yesterday's rapid test of our employee body. We DO have three known positive employees to report – one from Kinder Haus who has been quarantined for two weeks due to positive spouse contact. Another contract employee who also was exposed to a positive spouse, and an employee who had an outside positive exposure who has been in quarantine since learning of the friend's positive result. We have ten other results from our rapid test that have led us to perform a PCR test and we are shipping those samples off to the lab for confirmation or rejection of our results, results will be learned Saturday morning. Due to the work-location of several of these employees we will be forced to continue the current precautions that are in place until we have a chance to review the final outcomes

Also, with the Governor's announcement of his ending of the Stage 5 – full open status, we will be watching to see what additional precautions this brings for Swiss Village, as Adams County is currently defined as an orange-colored county. We know that with that designation there can be no gatherings of greater than 50 individuals, and Senior Care Centers are asked to restrict communal dining and close all gathering rooms/lounges. We will report out more as we continue to study the impact of his statement yesterday.

Residents and Responsible Parties, please continue to be patient with our attempts at protection and mitigation. I know these three+ weeks have been hard – it actually has been so hard for eight+ months! We will endure, we will get through this! I know we will, and we have had some excellent success at recoveries! As of today, our historical numbers stand at 56 residents, 51 employees and 7 contract employees who have tested positive, and 6 deaths. For recoveries we stand at 24 residents, 30 employees and 4 contract employees. We covet your continued prayers!

Employees, thank you for continuing to step up to help your peers and coworkers in this crisis period of shortages! We appreciate ALL that you do! We will continue to push through and come out shining on the other side of this! **TOGETHER!**
