Hello all! And may God grant you the wonderful peace that only He can bestow during difficult times! I have **NO NEW resident cases** to report to you today. However, I unfortunately need to share with you the results of our employee testing from this past week. We have an additional ten employees who have tested positive during our testing and other testing since Wednesday. It feels like we are turning the corner with this virus as we have had so very many recoveries and returns to work and original resident rooms... but we still creep slowly along with the positive test results. The Community spread in Adams County is beyond control, and I am sure our employees are mostly catching this bug from the Community spread... however, there is a likelihood that some spread has happened within these walls as well. And we are gaining a foothold! I will be anxious to update the total recoveries for all employees and residents later this week.

For now, however, our running totals now stand at 72 employees, 7 contract employees and 62 residents. We have lost a total of 6 precious souls (residents). As to recoveries, we are not yet changing our numbers, but we will be early in the coming week! I am pleased to report still a total of 48 residents, 42 employees and 5 contract employees to have fully recovered. Be on the lookout in the daily reports tomorrow or later for the revised numbers to these recovery totals! Excited to share, for sure, because God has blessed our employees and residents with mostly minimal cases of this virus and has healed so very many! We give Him the glory, for sure!

I think that is about all I will share with you for now. Unfortunately, with the County's increased positivity, our own continued positivity, and the lack of beds in our area hospitals, we are forced to continue our current path for at least the next fourteen days. Please bear with us while we endure and get closer and closer to the other side of this mess!! We are getting there, I promise! But for now, we need to remain vigilant. A couple of our current new positive cases are employees that interact daily on the AL/RL/IL side of the campus. For that reason, we will need to ride this out just a bit longer. We will deliver anything that is needed to you at a moment's notice! Please continue to pray for our afflicted employees that their cases may be minimized and that they can return to work well and soon! And also, for our residents who are currently recovering. We join you in those prayers and we expect that this situation will minimize over time. We are getting there **together!**
