Good morning. I am afraid I have more news that you are not going to like, and I would rather not have to give you. We have had four more employees test positive for the COVID-19 virus. Since several of these employees work in areas where there would be interaction with our Residential population, we now need to take more aggressive steps toward prevention and stopping any potential spread. We will be back tracing any and all contacts any of these employees may have had and we will also be testing all residents in RL and AL as soon as today.

To that end, please expect Alma and Heather to be knocking on your door sometime this afternoon if you live in Blumengarten, Steingarten or Langfeld. All congregate activities will once again need to cease for a period of time. Unfortunately, the Beauty Shop on Main St. will need to close for a period (Healthcare Beauty Shop can remain open as that area is still a green zone) and all dining will once again move to dining in your apartments. I am so very sorry for this to have happened again and thereby need to move back a step for a quarantine period, but we have no choice at the time. North Campus residents, once again, cannot enter the South Campus buildings, and South Campus residents can not go to the Wellness Center. This is going to pass... I know it is... we need the vaccine to come and we need as many of you, if not all of you, to be prepared to accept the vaccine when your turn has been called. This is so very critical so that we can get past these periods of Quarantine and isolation. Please bear with us and be patient.

If you normally dine in the main dining room, dietary has likely contacted you and/or placed a menu at your door for meal selection. Hopefully a two week period of time for this and we can get back to reopen... we'll have to see. But for now, this is how things must transpire until we receive the "all-clear". I am sorry about the timing as this is the most sacred week of each year... God is good, He gave us His Son, we will worship and give thanks – even in these times!

Please continue to attend to the good and safe hygienic practices that we have been preaching. Wash hands often, wear a mask always, practice safe social distancing, refrain from large social gatherings... please – it is so very important! Residents and Employees alike!

Totals now stand at 102 employees, 7 contract employees and 66 residents have tested positive. We have lost six residents. As of tomorrow, 95 employees, all 7 contract employees and 59 residents have fully recovered.
