Greetings Swiss Village family! I am pleased to report that we have had no new cases of COVID-19 since the employee-case that was reported to us this past week. Our understanding is that this employee is doing quite well having had minimal impact from the virus but we continue to pray for the well-being and health of this employee and the employee's family! The positive case did delay our ability to enable outdoor visits with Healthcare residents that was to have begun this past Monday. We will be revisiting the allowance of these visits as we clear the 14-day waiting period of onset of any new cases prior to allowing visits. More information on that procedure will be forthcoming in the next week.

The South Campus remains under the same restrictions that have been in existence since early March. Please remain on this campus at all times, except to take your car for a ride. If you are off campus in your car, please do not stop for any reason, visit with anyone while out, nor stop at any drive-through nor indoor restaurant. If you do so you are at risk of exposure and may need to self-quarantine in your apartment/unit upon your return. We do not wish to require that, but we are acting out of your best interest and the interest and safety of all. For non-healthcare residents of the South Campus we are allowing outdoor visits if you wish... but if you do so please limit your time for these visits to no longer than 30 minutes, maintain your six feet of social distancing at all times (sorry – no hugs as of yet!) and wear your mask at all times during the visit. The visitor should also be wearing a mask. We would further ask that you visit with no more than two or three visitors at any one time during these outdoor visits. Still no visitors into the building at any time, and non-Healthcare residents are still restricted from entering the Healthcare building.

Today almost all of our employees are going through the process of being tested for the COVID-19 virus. If we clear this test with no positive cases, we will be one step closer to being prepared to enter the next stage of opening our Healthcare building, but we must first be COVID-free for 14 days before advancing into that stage. Results from this testing will likely be returned to us early next week. Stay tuned for more information on our next steps. Thank you ALL for your continued patience and endurance during this Pandemic season.

And employees... thank you again for your being our heroes! You are the best! Continue your utmost attention on behalf of our residents, and thank you for your willingness to take the test!!
