RE: Weekly Update – Back on Track

Good day! I am happy to report that we, today, have no active cases of COVID-19 in our employee nor our resident families! We truly feel blessed to have had the experience that we have had to date! Further, we are receiving results from the mandated employee testing from a week ago. We have had 312 employees go through the testing... still awaiting results from four of those tests, but we are ecstatic to report that all results returned so far are **negative**! We have another 8 employees yet that are going to another testing site for their test as they were absent initially. If we continue to experience an all-negative result from this testing we will be one step closer to moving to Phase Two of a three-phase approach for reopening the Healthcare Center. But... there are weeks yet to go before we get to that point. Stay tuned.

Along those lines, however, because of the fact that we have had greater than 14 days of no-new-COVID reports from employees nor residents, we are able to move to outdoor visitations with Healthcare residents! These visits are slated to begin next Monday, and you will hear directly from Alma as to a more detailed announcement that includes all the mandated rules that we must follow in order to grant such visits. Please bear with us as I know all of you are anxious to be allowed to have brief visits in a new and exciting way!

Also new today: as of yesterday we have released the restrictions on our South Campus Independent Living residents, thereby enabling their return to the greater community for shopping, banking, pharmacy, appointments and visitation! We are still restricting visitation inside our building, including those apartments, but the residents are now allowed to move about – with extreme care, caution, and hopefully using wisdom about sanitizing hands often, social distancing and wearing of the mask at all times while in public. Further, we have also asked these residents that, if they go out and about, to please limit their access to the main part of the South Campus building as best they can until such time that it is able to open wider.

Still no visits inside the building of the Healthcare Center, even by residents. And, our residents in Residential Living, Assisted Living and Healthcare remain under the current restrictions until further notice.

Employees... I am SO PROUD of you! Your response to the “all-of-a-sudden” testing mandate from the State and the Feds... you overwhelmingly, and without-hesitation, responded, got your test, and now you are reporting the results! GREAT results! I cannot tell you about what comes next as the State has yet to develop and announce what their intentions are beyond the baseline testing that we all just went through. We will be sure to keep you informed as quickly as we learn anything at all. For those of you with tests still to come and results pending, please be sure to report to us any outcome that you learn, as quickly as you learn it. I would love to quickly announce some great results to our Public as we are able! As always, thank you so very much for all you do and have done to get us to this point... 3 ½ months in! Stay strong and stay well.
