Greetings all! This week's update contains old news and a bit of new news! First for the old news, as of today we still have no active cases of COVID-19 within the resident nor the employee families. We daily count our many blessings that we have benefitted from during this time and we thank God, Almighty!

The new news is the fact that the State of Indiana appears to be ready to allow healthcare facilities to begin allowing the public back into the buildings on limited basis. While somewhat skeptical, we are going to comply and attempt to arrange for the required amounts of visitations that will be allowed/mandated. We just sent out to all Healthcare responsible parties instructions for allowance of Essential Family Caregivers. Please refer to Alma's notice from yesterday. We will also be increasing the frequency of outdoor visitations to daily beginning Monday, July 6. We will also very shortly be incorporating some evening and weekend hours into those time slots as we are able. There is also a mandated "provision of indoor visits" that we will be trying to arrange for beginning July 17. These visits will be scheduled and arranged in the same fashion as the outdoor visits, and will be scheduled in a location yet-to-be-determined and announced – not in the residents' rooms. There will be signups generated for those visits. For all visits, there will be limited timeslots and all visitors will need to be screened prior to the visit, wear masks at all times, socially distance yourselves and use hand sanitizer. Be on the lookout for more instruction to that end.

All other residents, please continue to use good judgement about where you go. There will be more instruction in next week's update that will include a likely attention to the easing of even more of our current restrictions. Please stay tuned for that update, but for the time-being please continue with the current operative methods. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding while we wade through daily changes in guidance!
