However, if you are keeping up with the news, Indiana is not doing so well State-wide. The positivity rate is creeping up ever-closer to 10% (when we had been at a low of under 5% not too long ago) and the cases are mounting. I would not be surprised to hear of further restrictions coming out and a return to a lower Stage of “reopening”, to which at that time we will need to respond.
