RE: Weekly Update – Back on Track

Good morning! As we continue to see very low numbers of positive test results, I am pleased to share with you that all resident testing continues to result in zero positive results! With only one exception, the AL/RL residents have tested negative for a couple of months and the nursing residents have done so for weeks now! We rejoice in that fact and continue to put forth our keenest protective measures to keep the results the same. I must share, however, that two employees tested positive this week with results returned just yesterday. Out of over 200 tests, still only two positives, during what was projected to be a Christmas surge, is not bad at all. Both employees were totally asymptomatic, one of which had just returned from quarantine a couple of days earlier due to spousal positive contact. Both employees are now quarantined at their homes again for the duration. We are testing all employees again today via our lab testing, so results will likely not be known until late Saturday or Sunday. As both of these employees are nursing employees, the AL/RL/IL side of the operation is not impacted with any additional restrictions for now. However, we still request that there be no inside visitors in any of our buildings, and residents are asked to remain on campus and not venture out for trips/excursions. You may take your vehicle for a spin to exercise it and get yourself out... but please refrain from exiting your vehicle nor go through any drive through. This is still due to the surge that is happening in our County – we have hopes that might be easing, but we need to watch.

Our historical numbers are now 111 employees, 7 contract employees and 68 residents have contracted the virus since day one. Of those, 109 employees, all 7 contract employees and 62 residents have recovered. Still, 6 of our beloved residents succumbed while positive with the virus. We continue to thank God for how He has blessed us with keeping most all of our folks in a situation of low to no symptoms while positive, and for helping those who did have more severe reaction to fully recover after a period of time! We continue to pray for His protection going forward.

Our first vaccine clinic is scheduled for Monday! We will have a large group of residents and a group of employees scheduled to receive their first round accordingly. We are anxious to have this in place and continue to encourage as many of you who read this note to PLEASE plan to accept the vaccine. Sometime... somewhere! We can get to the other side of this pandemic and its social impact more quickly if everyone steps up. The remaining two clinics (if you miss this first clinic you may take advantage of the second or third – or schedule for the clinic at Adams Memorial) will be scheduled four weeks apart. In the meantime, please continue to practice all the safe hygienic practices that we have spoken of so often! Again, we are getting through this... **together!** Thank you for your ongoing support and prayers.
