RE: Back on Track – some GREAT news!

Well, now here's a way to start out a day! Some VERY good news! This week (just like last week) all resident test results AND all employee test results have returned **negative!** We happily report that, due to the fact that we have now gone at least fourteen days with no new resident nor employee cases of COVID-19, we can officially declare our outbreak – OVER! Concluded! We will not need to test residents any longer and we will only need to test employees as often as the State positivity dictates – our positivity in Adams County has been significantly declining and, because it is now under 10% we will only test employees once/week! If we can get the County rate under 5% we could actually move to once/month, but that might be a bit of time yet... but this is overall some of the best news I have been able to share in so very long!

We can now remove even more restrictions! Indoor visitations can start up once again, beginning **tomorrow!** For Healthcare, please sign up on the Sign-up Genius on our website (or call in for assistance) as those visits will still require reservations since our visit sites are limited. For the rest of the South Campus, you are free to come and go as you wish for trips and excursions... just please do not stay anywhere overnight as of yet as that would entail a 14-day quarantine upon your return. You are also free to have visitors, again, in your room/apartment (no more than two at a time). The visitation times are limited, as before, to the hours that there is a receptionist on duty at the main entrance, and, as before, all visitors must check in at the main entrance receptionist prior to going (directly) to the apartment from there. The same screening and questions will occur prior to every visit. Hours: Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturdays, 9:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Sundays, 11:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please help us by abiding by these hours and requirements. Please feel free to contact us for any questions or concerns or verification you may need.

We are further pleased to share that all of our active cases of COVID-19 have resolved themselves and we have no active cases at all among employees nor residents! Our historical numbers remain at 113 employees, 7 contract employees and 68 residents had contracted the virus. All employees, contract employees and 62 of our residents have fully recovered! As you are aware, we did lose 6 of our beloved residents to this virus, and we grieve that yet today!

Please continue to practice all of the safe hygienic practices you have heard from us so very often! And... if you have not yet received your first round of the vaccine, please sign up to do so at Adams County Memorial Hospital or at our on-site 2nd vaccine clinic scheduled for February 15. More details on that to follow. Thank you for your continued prayerful support! We thank YOU and we thank GOD for our good fortune, and we pray it only continues.
