RE: Weekly Update – Back on Track

DATE: February 12, 2021

Good morning! Yesterday we were advised by one of our IL residents on North Campus that they had tested positive for COVID-19 after an exposure to a positive family member last week. The resident is recovering and quarantining at home, and already had one of the two doses of the Vaccine on board when exposed. We pray that this episode will be minimal and brief... the spouse actually has both doses of the vaccine already on board and hopefully that can mitigate the concern for them both. This case on the North Campus, while most unfortunate, will not impact our current level of restrictions on the South Campus.

I am pleased to report, elsewhere, that we have no new cases of the virus within either the employee or the resident families on the South side! We rejoice that our experience has lightened greatly and that additionally, the County positivity rate continues to fall and remain very low! With that continued experience, and with our continued participation in greater vaccination participation, quite likely, before too long (but not before two weeks after the second vaccine clinic has concluded) we can talk about further reduction of restrictions! Please be patient with us... we are getting there, honest! But there is still some "row to hoe"! Until that time, again, if you have not yet made your decision to procure the vaccine, I urge you to please do so at your earliest convenience! On Monday we are holding our second vaccine clinic on campus and in four weeks (March 15) we will hold the third and final clinic here. If you are not on the schedule for our clinics, PLEASE consider registering for one of the clinics held at Adams Memorial Hospital or at the Adams County Health Department. I cannot stress enough the importance of obtaining your vaccination to help eradicate and reduce the effects of this pandemic! Our residents are counting on YOU! If you have any questions about these clinics, please feel free to contact us and we can help direct you accordingly.

Our historical totals from the impact of the virus stand at: 113 employees and 7 contract employees have contracted the virus and all of them have recovered and returned to work! We now stand at 69 residents contracting the virus and 62 of those residents recovered accordingly.

Please continue to practice all the safe hygienic practices that have been preached and preached previously, EVEN IF you have been fully vaccinated. Until instructed otherwise by the scientists and the CDC and our Departments of Health, we need to continue all protective measures for some time. As you can see from above, even if you have had one of the vaccinations, you can still come down with the bug! Please help us help you! And remember, we will get through all of this... **together!**
