Greetings all! As of this writing, Swiss Village continues to remain COVID-19-free in our employee family and in our resident family! While this is a very good thing we continue to remain vigilant in keeping the “bug” from entering our campus and buildings. It is for this reason that our current restrictions to visitors and our restrictions on leaving campuses remain in place! Please help us to continue the good pattern of COVID-free experience! It is up to each and every one of you.

Last week I released plans for the loosening of some restrictions for the North Campus residents, including the opening of Muselman Wellness Center for use by these residents (only for now). Please refer to last week’s memo for more details on that information. And please remember, as you are out and about after Monday, to use extreme caution, good judgement, good sanitation and social distancing. Please remember to wear your masks any time you are in the public. Also, please be mindful that, as you are able to be out and about as of that time, we will no longer be offering grocery, pharmacy and book/puzzle pick-up and delivery to the North Campus as of this date. We will, however, for a period of time, still deliver lunches for those that still wish to receive them. If you would still like puzzles or books from the south campus please contact the activities department and they will make arrangements to leave those between the two front doors at the main entrance for you to pick-up.

Finally, we are following the development of new guidelines that may be imposed on Nursing Facilities as steps for reopening those buildings. We currently meet all criteria with one major exception. In order for facilities to reopen, it is looking more and more like all residents and staff may need to have baseline testing for the COVID-19 virus. The ruling is not yet finalized, and we will keep you informed as to whether or not this becomes the standard and how we will address our own compliance with that guideline. You have likely heard some of this mentioned in the news as VP Pence was the one to publicly extend the push for such testing to occur. We are wary of how, exactly, to make this happen, and will follow diligently the rules as they develop... and notify you accordingly.

Thank you for your continued prayers, support and patience as we continue to endure the COVID-19 impact. And we are thankful to God our Father for His unwavering love and protection.
