Good day! And we continue to hope that you and we have “good days”! Today I write you with information up to date. As of this writing we have ***no currently active cases of COVID-19 in our employee family nor in our resident family!*** Our total case-count to date stands at 6 employee (2 of which were contract employees) and 1 resident. Nearly all of our “cases” were totally asymptomatic (including our one resident) which leads us to wonder about false positives for them with a couple of the employees reporting minimal impact from any symptoms at all. We continue to express gratitude for God’s watchful eye over our population and pray that such continues for the duration of this pandemic period! Today we are testing all employees once again... and tomorrow we will test the residents of the Nursing Center. If, as has been the case for the last few weeks, we have zero positive results from this testing we will be able to return to the testing frequency associated with our County’s positivity rate – which still hovers just below 5% meaning next week, if all goes as hoped, we won’t need to test again! That would be a pleasant change, for sure. Your prayers for same are coveted!

As has been previously reported, this week we opened our South Campus for wider range of visitation to the non-nursing areas. The nursing areas are still open for visitation as per the last bunches of weeks (indoor/outdoor – sign up via “sign up genius” accessed by our COVID Information link on the web page or call in) with time limits and designated locations. In our other areas, however, (Assisted Living, Residential Living and Independent Living areas of the South Campus) visitors (only two at any time) may come into the building at the main entrance, be screened for temperature and answer a few questions, and if clear can continue directly to the resident’s unit for their visit! We are pleased to be able to bring this opportunity to you and our residents, and we will continue to allow such visits so long as there are no noted outbreaks on our campus or in our Community for which we would need to take further action and shut back down. Please refer to the rules for these visits as are posted on our COVID Information Link on our web page. Explanation of the rules (i.e. – please always maintain social distance and wear masks and adhere to the hours of allowed visitation) is found therein and we appreciate your adherence to working with us during this profound period.

Thank you each and our highly valued employees for your continued patience and persistent adherence to the required good hygienic practices that are required at this time. We are getting through this ***together!***
